

# RESPONSIBLE BEVERAGE (311)

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## **311-400. Responsible Bev Tobacco Serv. (0.1 Credits)**

Designed to educate owners/operators and employees of the food and beverage industry on responsible beverage service. Responsible service of alcoholic beverages will be explored. In addition, state and federal tobacco laws will be examined. The course fulfills Wisconsin Statutes which require alcohol sellers and servers, including new applicants/bartenders/operators, to complete training before a license is issued. A certificate will be awarded upon satisfactory completion of the course. ## **311-472A. Responsible Beverage Service. (0.1 Credits)**

Meet the Wisconsin State requirements for certification relating to the selling/serving of alcoholic products upon course completion. Geared to educate people employed in bars, restaurants and retail package stores on the local and state laws pertaining to the sale/service of alcoholic beverages. Methods of intervention to prevent a patron from becoming intoxicated will be discussed. This course is also included in the Mixology course, #109-418A.
